What we do

Co2mmunity Key Facts

Aim: Support citizens to co-finance, co-develop, and co-operate sustainable energy projects.

Budget: € 3.15 million, thereof € 2.45 million from the European Union (European Regional Development Fund)

Project period: Oct 2017 to Sep 2020
